TRAFFIC CITATIONS

When you receive a citation, there will be an appearance date and time listed on the citation. This is the date and time in which you must pay your citation or contest your citation. Contact the court by that date and time, to arrange a payment plan, or to contest the charges on the citation and set your case for a pretrial.

When a citation states that you must appear in Court, rather than listing a fine or bail amount, it is a mandatory appearance on the date and time listed on the citation. YOU MUST APPEAR PERSONALLY.

For legal questions, contact an attorney. The Court is prohibited by State Law from giving legal advice.

The Court does not reduce, amend or dismiss any citation.

The Courts in Elko County do not offer traffic school.

The Court does not access the points on your license. For concerns about points contact your state licensing DMV.

The Court accepts payments in the following forms:

- Cashier's Check
- Credit/Debit card- a convenience fee is charged.
- Cash, when paying in person-DO NOT SEND CASH THROUGH THE MAIL.
